



PORTS REGULATION FOR ANDØY HAVN KF 2026

ADOPTED BY THE PORT BOARD THE 20th. of November 2025



ENGLISH LANGUAGE

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GENERAL PROVISIONS

Regulations for the Andøy Havn KF have been laid down on the basis of laws and regulations as follows:

The ports and Fairways Act of 21st. June 2019 no. 70 entered into force on 1st. January 2020

1. The ports and Fairways Act of 21st. June 2019 no. 70 entered into force on 1st. January 2020
2. ACT-2019-06-21-70 on ports and waters, § 29. As a provider of ports and transport services, the port authority of Andøy Havn KF has the right to set prices and other terms and conditions. These must be published in an overview of prices and other terms and conditions, ref. the port regulations.
3. ACT-2019-06-21-70 on Ports and Waters § 36, Water Tax
4. FOR-2019-12-21-1790, Regulations on Vessel's Notification Obligations pursuant to the Act on Ports and Waters
5. FOR-2019-12-11-1836, "Regulations on the duty of disclosure for transport - planning" where the municipality must provide information about calls of vessels to Statistics Norway as stipulated by the Ministry of Transport and communications.
6. Articles of Association for Andøy Havn KF adopted by Andøy Municipal Council on 09.12.2013, adjusted by Andøy Municipal Council in a meeting on 12.05.2014.
7. Regulation on Water Tax in Andøy Municipality's Sea Area laid down by Board of Directors of the port of Andøy Havn KF on 01.12.2020 pursuant to Andøy Municipality's delegation decision as new articles of association to Andøy Havn KF of 09.12.2013, last adjusted on 12.05.2014.
8. The fee regulation applies to the entire port district, and has been adopted by the Board of Directors of the Port of Andøy Havn KF on 01.12.2020 pursuant to Andøy Municipality's delegation decision as new articles of association to Andøy Havn KF on 15.12.2015. Revised on 21.03.2016, on 02.01.2018 and 17.03.2020 and 08.10.2020.

CLAIM RECOVERY

Claims for unpaid fees that Andøy Havn KF has against the owner, shipowner or agent after § 36 of the Act relating to Port and Waters may be enforced pursuant to the Act relating to Ports and waters §§ 40 and 41.

The claim has a lien on a ship or cargo pursuant to §36 and the rules on maritime liens in the Act of 24 June 1994 No. 39 on shipping.

FEES / CHARGES / REMUNERATIONS

Fees / Charges / Remunerations shall be paid by all vessels in commercial operation on the basis of gross tonnage in accordance with the International Convention on the Measurement of Vessels of 1969, or for smaller fishing boats, the length of the vessel.

In cases where it is not possible to determine the size / tonnage of the vessel according to certain information, the size / tonnage is determined by the port authority.

WATER TAX

(Reduced by 50% from 2025 and until further notice)

Legal basis: ACT-2019-06-12-70 on ports and waters, §36 and regulations laid down by Andøy Havn KF on 01.12.2020 pursuant to Andøy municipality's delegation decision. New articles of association to Andøy Havn KF of 09.12.2013, adjusted by Andøy Municipal Council in a meeting on 12.05.2014.

With the exception mentioned below, all vessels calling at ports in Andøy municipal area, pay the waterway taxes to Andøy Havn KF according to the following rates in NOK:

The tax applies per port call. (In the event of repeated calls within the same day, the tax will only be charged once per day).

A 1: Vessels operating or cooperating with Andøya Space Defence regarding regarding NMSI tests, vessels that operate or are in cooperation with GPS Jamming exercises, is invoiced for the water tax in accordance with the Andøy Havn KF's regulations.

A 2: Vessels used for commercial fishing, and over 15 metres l.o.a., shall pay the water tax in accordance with the following table below : Rate in NOK

A 3: Vessels used for passenger transport are invoiced in accordance with their own regulations as follows:

Vessels under 2000 GT: NOK 445 per day.

Vessels over 2000 GT : NOK 550 per day.

A 4: Vessels used for passenger transport in the Municipality's waters / sea area and which is in layup, pays according to the following rates:

Under 1000 GT: NOK 436 per month.

EXEMPTION FROM PAYING WATER TAX

- A vessel making a port call due to damage or an emergency condition and the vessel do not loading, unloading or taking on board passengers.
- Salvage and icebreaker vessels during operation of salvage or icebreaking.
- Vessels making a port call solely for the purpose of disembarking sick, shipwrecked or dead persons, provided that the stay in the port does not last longer than necessary for the performance of this.
- Naval vessels, both foreign and Norwegian, as well as vessels belonging to the Norwegian or foreign state, when not used for the carriage of goods or passengers in return for payment, or is run by the state's commercial activities.
- Vessels of less than 15 meters in length.
- Vessels with historical value of less than 25 GT with a declaration from the Directorate for Cultural Heritage can apply for exemption if belonging within Andøy municipality. When granting such an exemption, vessel will be exempt from quay charges.
Electricity, refuse collection, snow ploughing and water must be paid.
The harbour master allocates berths as needed.
The harbour master may revoke such a decision if the management of the vessel does not comply messages given regarding given berth position and the like.

The remuneration is paid once a day, or part thereof. Remuneration is always paid for minimum 1 day.

- In the case of calls in the period 01.11.- 30.04., a fee of **NOK 165** per month shall be paid for covering: Snow ploughing regardless of the length of the stay.
- Ships are invoiced for cleaning according to invoice.

The period of stay is counted from the vessel's arrival quayside and until it leaves again.

For vessels which, by order of the port authorities, must leave the berth to make room for another vessel and dock again, the lying time is counted as if the vessel has been quayside all the time

if the absence from the berthing position has not lasted more than 3 hours. If it is more than 3 hours, it must be done deduction from the calculated period of berthing for the time the vessel has been away.

If a vessel changes berths at the municipality's quays to another quay, without in the meantime has been outside the boundaries of the port district, the lying time is to be regarded as if the vessel without interruption had been at the quay.

A vessel laying at the municipality's quay, outside another vessel and has connection to shore over the latter vessel, shall pay a full berth fee.

State vessels are exempt from the berth fee if they are not used for the transport of goods or passengers for remuneration or are operated by the state's commercial enterprises.

K 2:

Vessels used for commercial fishing shall pay a berth fee calculated in accordance with the vessel's length (l.o.a.). The fee applies to all municipality's berths or other mooring facilities such as floating docks and buoys that are not covered by other fees in the regulations.

Quay fee **NOK 4.25** per meter per day. Remuneration is always paid for a minimum of one day.

Vessels anchoring in the outer reef shall pay a fee of **NOK 1100** per day.

GOODS FEE

1. Goods fee applies to all goods transported by ship to or from the ports of Andøy municipality and which is carried over municipal quays.
2. Goods fee may be imposed on goods that are transferred from one vessel to another without passing through the quay, if one of the vessels is berthed. The fee will then be on third of what which is intended for goods that are transported over the quay.
3. The goods fee covers the storage of goods on quays, areas or facilities disposed by the municipality up to 48 hours after the end of the unloading of the ship, or up to 48 hours before the loading of the ship starts.
4. The goods fee for incoming goods is the responsibility of the consignee of the goods. For outgoing goods, the fee is sent to the consignor. This shall not prevent the commodity fee in the case of domestic shipments by agreement are imposed by others.
5. As a condition for freight forwarders to be allowed to expedite goods over Andøy Havn KF's quays and areas, they may be ordered to collect it at any time the expense of Andøy Havn KF, the stipulated commodity fee. Remuneration for collection is set at 25% of what is the collected amount
6. Consignees or consignors of goods, freight forwarders, masters and others who directly or indirectly mediates traffic from, to or within the port district is obliged to provide the port authorities stated the nature, quantity, dispatch or destination, passenger numbers, etc.
7. The fee shall be calculated according to the weight / unit of measurement that gives rise to the largest fee

For goods brought on board or ashore over the municipality's quays, the following must be paid in

Fees / Remuneration:

- For goods with only specified cubic dimensions the following is calculated: 1 cbm = 1,5 tonnes
- Sand, shingle, cement and asphalt : 1 cbm = 1,5 tonnes
- Lumber stated in standard : 1 standard = 4,6 cbm

Discounts for larger quantities of goods or containers may be agreed.

TERMINAL FEE

Goods that are transported by wagon and on - an unload on the port's areas or goods shed shall pay a terminal fee. The rates for this tax shall be the same as for goods fee.

Exempt from this consideration are goods that are charged with goods fee.

REMUNERATION

Remuneration is paid for Andøy Havn KF's cost in connection with services and for use of land areas and special port facilities in the port district that are not covered by the port fees and water taxes.

PASSENGER FEES

All vessels / boats used for passenger traffic / excursions must pay a passenger supplement when using a port in the Port of Andøy Havn KF's sea district.

Amount of the remuneration shall be **NOK 15.-** per passenger.

* If the lease is terminated after a shorter period of time, there will be no refund.

** The deposit applies to all new boats and will be written down by **10 %** per year.

*** If the previous owner has not cleared the space after themselves, a clean-up fee will be charged.

MOORING SERVICE / ON - CALL SERVICE

- If mooring assistance is required, the vessel will be charged with NOK 1100.- per hour during ordinary working hours.
Outside ordinary working hours, overtime supplements are calculated.

In the event of a call - out due to errors :

If the fault lies with the user, the call-out rate is increased to NOK 3000.- per hour ordinary time plus hourly rates. Outside ordinary hours, overtime supplements are calculated.

- Boat transport and mooring boat with crew are covered by the vessel in question according to the rates and regulations in force all times.

WASTE COLLECTION FEE

All vessels moored at Andøy Havn KF's quays must pay a waste collection fee according to the following rates per week in NOK :

Vessels that deliver larger quantities garbage shall pay NOK 500,00 pr m³.

Vessels that are docked for more than a week shall pay a fee once per week that has begun.

Vessels used for commercial fishing, or pleasure craft, shall pay the following fee per week :

The fee shall be paid by all vessels that arrives / are berthed at Andøy Havn KF's quays, but only once a week.

POTWATER FILLING

Overtime is calculated outside ordinary working hours.

RENTAL OF FORKLIFTS

Remuneration for renting a harbour forklift	
kr 900	with driver per hour - ex VAT
kr 700	without driver per hour - ex VAT

Rental of forklifts can only occur during normal working hours.

FEE ON OVERHEAD GOODS

- Goods or Items must only be landed in places designated by the port inspector and can be located for free for 48 hours.
- If the Harbour Master allows the goods to be stored longer than 48 hours, they are paid for excess time a storage fee of NOK 3,80 pr m² for occupied space per day.
- Storage of goods at Andøy Havn KF's open spaces can be allowed upon request to the port office where the rental fee is determined in each individual case.
- For transit and transit goods that are unloaded for onward shipment, payment of a half rate is made after 48 hours.

The Port Master may, if he deems it necessary, require unloaded goods to be collected before the expiry of the free time (48 hours). In this context, it must be ensured, as far as possible, that the goods stored for longest time, is picked up first.

Andøy Havn KF is not responsible for the goods that are stored on its areas, quays or sheds.

Goods that is stored on quays areas or in sheds without consent, or that are left for longer time than allowed, may be removed or stored by the Port Authority at the expense of the consignee or consignor concerned.

If such goods are not collected within three months, the Port Authority may sell them by public auction or regular announcement. Goods that do not provide security for costs incurred, or that is easily prone to spoilage, or that may cause damage, the Port Authority has the right to sell within three months or destroy if necessary.

POWER SUPPLY 220 V

Vessels that connect to current meters must note the meter reading and the date of connection and disconnection, as well as listing the boat's name and number.

The price per Kw/h is NOK 2,67 excl. VAT

BOAT SETUP

For boats that are put ashore at Andøy Havn KF's quay areas, a fee shall be paid per m² /day. The area is calculated according to the boat's width x length (l.o.a.).

Price per. m ² per. day :	kr 4,00
Lump sum when setting up a boat :	kr 650,00

VARIOUS PROVISIONS

In the event that remuneration would otherwise have been lost, the Harbour Master is authorised to deviate from the remuneration rates in this regulation.

Invoice fee : There is an invoice fee of NOK 53,00 per invoice.

ISPS FEE

Andøy Havn KF invoices ISPS vessels general ISPS fee to cover expenses with port security at terminals subject to the Port Security Regulation as follows.

AREAS

1. For buildings, warehouses or other fixed installations at the Port of Andøy Havn KF's areas are paid with a rent of NOK 43,00 per m² per year.
2. For temporary storage on Andøy Havn KF's areas, there shall be paid a rent of NOK 48,00 pr. m².
3. The size of the area is agreed in advance between Andøy Havn KF and the tenant.
4. Andøy Havn KF measures and marks the storage area in cooperation with the tenant.
5. Andøy Havn KF is not responsible for goods or other material stored at Andøy Havn KF's areas.

PARKING AT ANDØY HAVN KF'S AREAS

1. Andøy Havn KF shall approve areas to be used as parking areas within Andøy Havn KF's areas.
2. Vehicles that are parked / left on Andøy Havn KF's areas without permission may be removed at the owner's expense.

CASE PROCESSING FEE

LEGAL BASIS :

For the processing of applications for permits pursuant to Act - 2019-06-21-70 on ports and waters §§ 14, 15 and 16, Andøy Havn KF has stipulated that a fee shall be paid.

The fee shall be paid regardless of whether permission is granted or refused.

The fee is paid as follows :
